



Frequently Asked Questions

- What is the best way to watch the art?
 - Projector
 - “Cast” or “Screen Mirror” to your Chromecast or Apple TV with either a phone or laptop
 - Connect your laptop directly to your TV with HDMI or VGA
- What is the best medium for projection?
 - White or light-colored walls are best. Hanging a sheet is a fun, old-school option. Garage doors can also make a good “screen” and if you’re feeling creative, find a way to project onto the ceiling! If you are not viewing with a projector, we suggest using your TV, laptop or phone to view the digital art.
- What is the best time to project & view your art?
 - If projecting outside, we suggest looking at your local sunset time for that day. We find it is easiest to get set-up while there is still daylight and then project once it is dark out.
 - If viewing inside, anytime will work as long as you are able to create a dark space (turn off lights, close blinds and curtains) for optimal viewing.
- What is the best way to incorporate the audio that goes along with the art?
 - The art for #DGathome is accompanied by music so, it’s important to have a way to hear it! The vessel connected to your projector (typically a laptop or phone) likely has speakers built in. For additional sound, you can connect your phone or laptop to a Bluetooth speaker or other speaker accessories.
- Other tips to note...
 - It is important to have a strong internet connection for the sake of view the production.
 - Allow your video time to load fully prior to showing the production so you do not run into any “buffering” issues.
